

Remarks

Lawrence County is in far western South Dakota against the Wyoming state line. It has been a Republican stronghold in presidential elections since 1920, backing every Republican nominee since then, and with all but four races in that span decided by more than ten points. The county has experienced modest population growth since the 1970s.

Due to unavailability of 2012 election data, a quantifiable estimate of election manipulation is made difficult; however, it is likely that three precincts rate *high* for statistical indication of election manipulation, containing a minimum of 150 likely fraudulent ballots each — Rural #2, Spearfish 2, and Lead. All precincts appearing in the *worst precincts* list should be prioritized for canvassing to identify voter registration illegalities, especially since voter registration fraud in South Dakota has been proven to be prevalent, particularly in transient living quarters such as RV parks, apartments, and assisted living centers.
