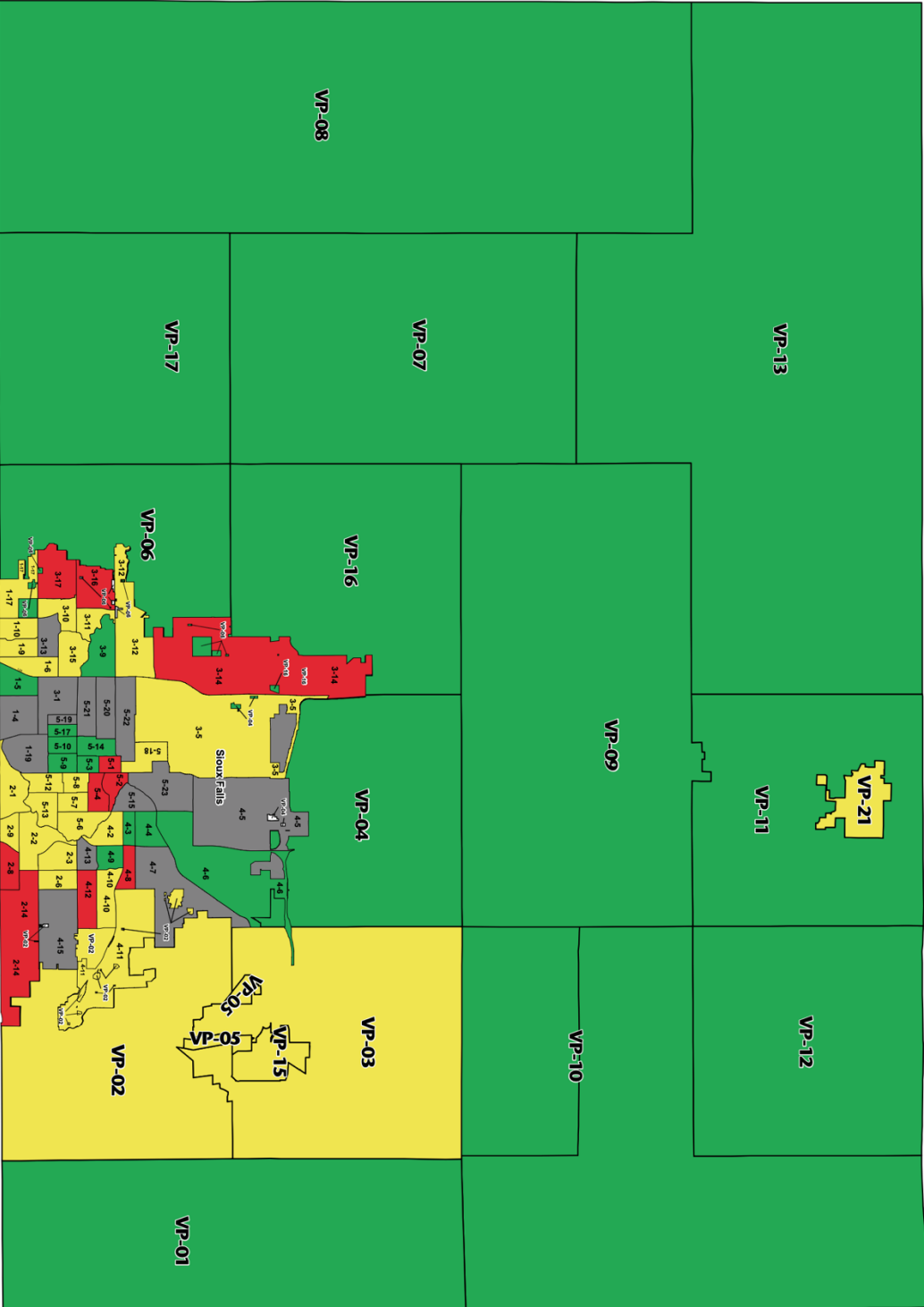

Remarks

Minnehaha County is the largest county in South Dakota and contains the state's largest city, Sioux Falls. It has grown by at least 21,187 net new residents in each of the past three decades and continues to receive out of state transplants from surrounding states, which has contributed to its continued suburban growth, also extending south into Lincoln County. It has backed Republican presidential nominees in 10 of the past 14 elections, although the 2020 election result shows substantial statistical evidence of manipulation.

It is likely that at least 10,482 fraudulent ballots were cast in the 2020 presidential election in Minnehaha County, and the most disparate precincts are sporadically located mostly around the outskirts of Sioux Falls itself, with each precinct rated high for statistical indication of election manipulation (colored *red* on the map) containing between 150 and 300 likely fraudulent

ballots. Very little indication of statistical disparity is present in rural Minnehaha County, neither to the west of Sioux Falls, or along the Minnesota and Iowa state lines. All precincts appearing in the *worst precincts* list should be prioritized for canvassing to identify voter registration illegalities, especially since voter registration fraud in South Dakota has been proven to be prevalent, particularly in transient living quarters such as RV parks, apartments, and assisted living centers.
