





Same Source Different Numbers




SD SOS Web Site on 4/2/2021 Shows 427,529 Ballots Cast in the state SD SOS Total Votes County - 422,609 that's **4,920 short** SD SOS Data from 9/22/2021 shows 428,501 total votes – **972 votes over** SD SOS Data from 12/29/2021 shows 427,074 total votes – **455 votes under**.

Interesting Tidbits



When we looked at the 9/22/2021 data set we found:

- 163 Voters Voted on 11/3/2020, were Registered after the election.
- 552 voters registered 11/3/2020 and 49 voted in 11/3/2020 election
- 260 voters that voted on 11/3/2020 registered between 10/20/2020-11/3/2020 = not legal.
- Last legal date to register to vote for the 11/3/2020 election was 10/19/2020.
- Registrations 10/20/2020 and beyond are late per SDCL 12-4-5.
- 11 voters voted TWICE.
- 256 Voters with original registration date 100 years ago or more. 227 them are active status. This makes them 118 years old or older. The oldest person alive in USA is 113.



The Magic is Amazing

When we looked at the 12/29/2021 data set we found:

- 146 new records from 9/22/2021 with voter history for 11/3/2020 not recorded previously.
- 601 voter records removed since 9/22/2021 database.
- 36 new voters with original registration date 09.22.21 thru 12.23.21 VOTED 11/3/2020!
- 18 Records completely blank with active votes on 11/03/2020.

ONGOING ISSUE:

- Newly registered voters from end of 2020 NOW with a vote recorded for 11/3/2020.
- This is a phenomenon for every election.





Failing grade for voter roll maintenance NCOA database comparison Social Security Master Death Index to remove deceased voters

We collected affidavits of:

Stolen Votes – vote was cast for a voter who did not vote

Phantom Votes – vote was cast by someone who doesn't live at that address

Lost Votes – voter claimed they voted, but there was no record of their vote

Deceased Votes – vote was recorded for voter after their date of death

Duplicate Votes – voters found at one address registered under two names with votes cast for both

Who is in Charge of the Voter Rolls?

The County Auditor Maintains the Voter Rolls:

<u>12-4-2</u>. County auditor in charge of voter registration records.

• The county auditor has complete charge of maintaining and safeguarding the voter registration records in the county. The county auditor shall retain all voter registration records in the auditor's office in paper or electronic form. All such records shall be open to public inspection at all times during office hours, except pursuant to \$

<u>12-4-9</u>. Master registration file--Contents--Public inspection--Limitations.


• The county auditor shall maintain and safeguard a file of voters in computer format that contains the information of each person registered in each voting precinct within the county. This file shall be known as the master registration file and shall be, at all times during office hours, open to public inspection. However, public access to social security numbers, driver license numbers, and dates of birth contained in the master registration file is prohibited. The master registration file shall contain all information from each voter's registration card. The master registration file shall also include the date of the last election the voter has voted in and when the voter's information was last updated. The master registration file may also contain additional voter history information. Any voter registration form for a purged or unregistered voter shall be kept for twenty-two months. No purged or unregistered voter may be included in the master registration file.

The County Auditor Maintains the Voter Rolls: Or do they?

- DMV and State Agency registrations bypass the Auditor.
- DMV and Mail Forwarding Companies auto filling voter registration and digitally affixing signatures.
- Auditor required to PAY the SOS office \$1.00/page for original documents to review registration qualifications.
- SOS office creates Total Vote user name and password for Auditor NOT SECURE.
- Auditor told they do not have authority to purge voter rolls despite having knowledge of thousands that were not removed that should have been.

WHAT IS BPRO?

- Voter Roll Maintenance and Election Night Reporting System
- Located in Pierre, SD
- Created with HAVA Funds, commissioned by Chris Nelson
- First SOS Contract with Bpro 2007 (CERS)
- Bpro expanded from voter roll maintenance to a centralized top-down election managing system
- 2009 Nelson gives Total Vote to North Dakota. Campea buys Bpro.
- 2015 Jason Gant (former SOS) gave away the state owned source code to TOTAL VOTE to New Mexico in exchange for a sole source contract with Bpro. (Valued at \$1 million)

WHAT IS BPRO?

- 2020 Knowink receives \$10 million in capital from Hermann Cos for acquisitions. COO on the Board of Knowink.
- 2020 Bpro bought out by Knowink of St. Louis.
- Knowink sells E-Poll Pads.
- Bpro locations and employees retained.



WHAT IS BPRO?

- Bpro secured contracts with states such as North Dakota, Nebraska, Hawaii, Montana, Iowa, ARIZONA, Hawaii, Washington (\$10 million), PENNSYLVANIA (\$10 million), Oregon (\$7 million), and more.
- Voter Rolls on Microsoft Azure cloud.
- DHS/CISA/CIS Albert Sensors on Microsoft Azure cloud.
- Fully interfaces with ERIC, AAMVA, DMV, NCOA and any or all state agencies.
- Knowink is in 35 states.
- Competitors are Tenex and VR Systems All virtually the same program.


- Electronic poll books are connected to the internet.

- E-Poll Books are NOT a certified piece of voting equipment.
- E-Poll Books allow for vote centers or super-precincts.
- Pennington County had check-in problems and poll book crashes in prior elections and discontinued use.




Condidate W of their Eventual Total at Disalayed Time





Most data seems fine, until you take a closer look at some races where the vote totals dropped....this is highly unusual and requires further explanation as to why and how this can happen.







However, South Dakota Secretary of State Steve Barnett and county auditors who run local elections say they have reviewed the concerns and concluded that the electoral process in place in South Dakota is secure and that voters can trust the results of the Nov. 8, 2022, election.

"I'm very confident in our system, which is a bottom-up approach led by auditors at the county level, and I also know that our election laws are strong," Barnett said. "We have paper ballots, our tabulating machines are not connected to the internet, and a statewide canvass is completed after election day."

BPro is experienced with the data structure of voter registration data and data conversions through our successful delivery of election systems in six states. This includes building the South Dakota and Washington Voter Registration systems, which changed from "bottom-up" to "top-down" models with the implementation of TotalVote. In addition, BPro has built data exchanges for our customers to participate in both ERIC and Cross Check, in order to compare voter registration data with other states.

"When a person votes on Election Day, the ballot is counted by a tabulator and then transferred into our system," explains Campea. "Our software reports the results and provides them to the media outlets."

He adds "We're the official people who know the results before anyone else."

BPro staff are the first-receivers of election results in South Dakota and six other states-Montana, North Dakota, Nebraska, Hawaii, New Mexico and most recently Oregon, as well as Sacramento County in California and 11 Minnesota counties




