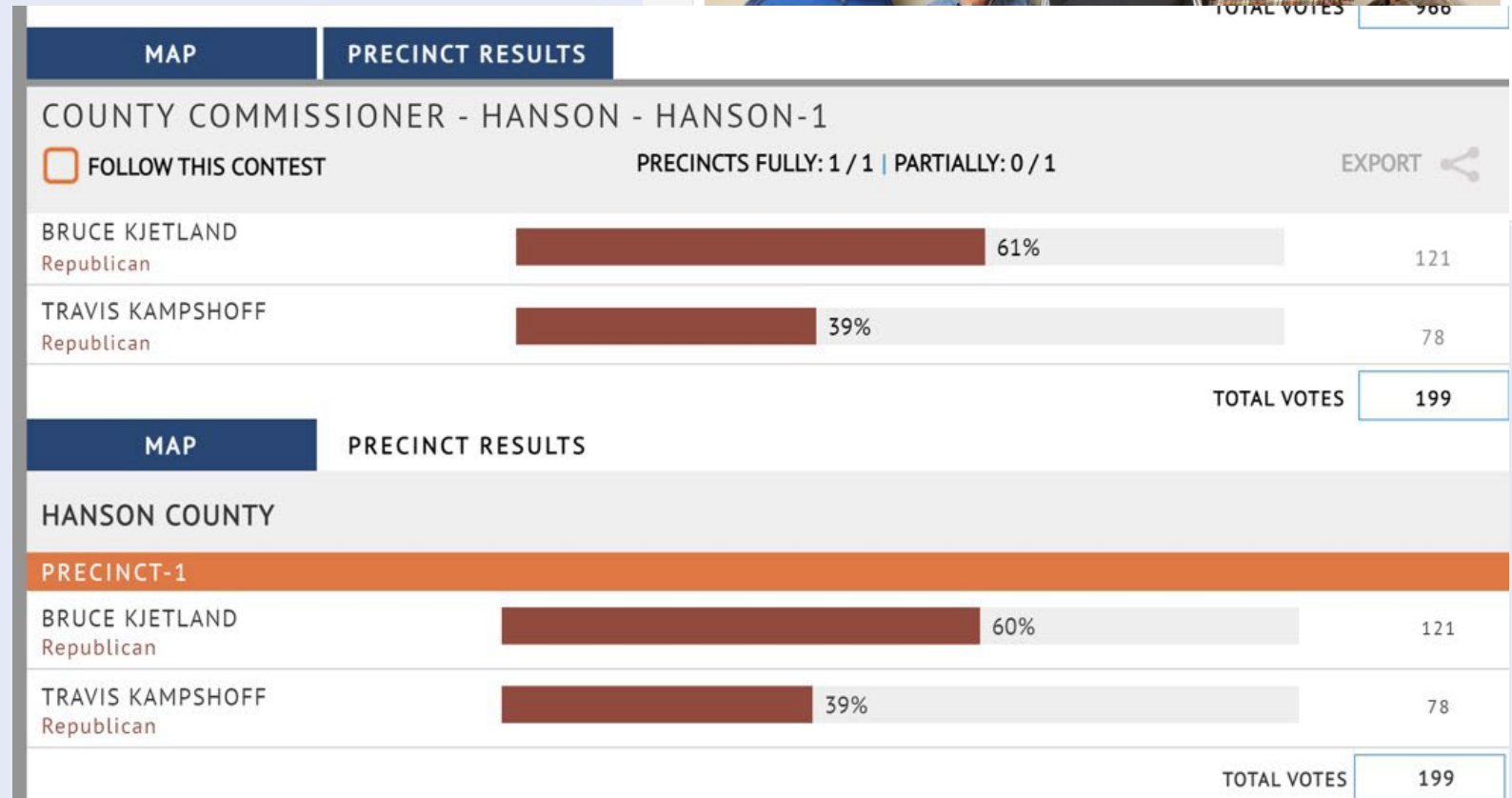

# Results From Door to Door Canvassing

# We collected affidavits of:

**Stolen Votes** – vote was cast for a voter who did not vote

**Phantom Votes** – vote was cast by someone who doesn't live at that address

**Lost Votes** – voter claimed they voted, but there was no record of their vote

**Deceased Votes** – vote was recorded for voter after their date of death

**Duplicate Votes** – voters found at one address registered under two names with votes cast for both



# Examples of Affidavits from Stolen Votes

2022. Mr. Stubbe stated he does not live in S.D. but is a full-time RVer. Mr. Stubbe stated he did not vote in the 2020 general election, however, the S.D. voter rolls record a ballot was cast for Mr. Stubbe on 11-3-2020.

Jeraldine [REDACTED] stated she never voted in the 2020 General Election but it says she voted in the 2020 General Election. Her P.O. box is [REDACTED] St [REDACTED] She received an Absentee ballot but stated she never sent it in.

# Who is in Charge of the Voter Rolls?

## The County Auditor Maintains the Voter Rolls:

- **12-4-2. County auditor in charge of voter registration records.**

- **The county auditor has complete charge of maintaining and safeguarding the voter registration records in the county.** The county auditor shall retain all voter registration records in the auditor's office in paper or electronic form. All such records shall be open to public inspection at all times during office hours, except pursuant to §§ 12-4-9 and 12-4-9.3.

- **12-4-9. Master registration file--Contents--Public inspection--Limitations.**

- **The county auditor shall maintain and safeguard a file of voters in computer format that contains the information of each person registered in each voting precinct within the county. This file shall be known as the master registration file and shall be, at all times during office hours, open to public inspection. However, public access to social security numbers, driver license numbers, and dates of birth contained in the master registration file is prohibited. The master registration file shall contain all information from each voter's registration card. The master registration file shall also include the date of the last election the voter has voted in and when the voter's information was last updated. The master registration file may also contain additional voter history information. Any voter registration form for a purged or unregistered voter shall be kept for twenty-two months. No purged or unregistered voter may be included in the master registration file.**

# The County Auditor Maintains the Voter Rolls: Or do they?

- DMV and State Agency registrations bypass the Auditor.
- DMV and Mail Forwarding Companies auto filling voter registration and digitally affixing signatures.
- Auditor required to PAY the SOS office \$1.00/page for original documents to review registration qualifications.
- SOS office creates TotalVote user names and passwords - NOT SECURE.
- Auditor told they do not have authority to purge voter rolls despite having knowledge of thousands that were not removed that should have been.

# China was using a Flaw in Microsoft Cloud to Hack on US Government Officials.

In a high-profile security breach, a group of hackers linked to the Beijing government have accessed the email account of the U.S. ambassador to China, Nicholas Burns, and Daniel Kritenbrink, the assistant secretary of state for East Asia, The [\*\*Wall Street Journal\*\*](#) reported.

The Gateway Pundit previously [\*\*reported\*\*](#) that China was using a flaw in Microsoft Cloud to launch a cyberattack on US government officials' email accounts.

[\*\*According\*\*](#) to the New York Times, "the hack, by a Chinese group that the company said was intent on conducting espionage, went undetected for a month."

"Chinese hackers penetrated the email accounts of Commerce Secretary Gina Raimondo and other State and Commerce Department officials in the weeks before Secretary of State Antony J. Blinken traveled to Beijing in June, U.S. officials said on Wednesday," the outlet reported.

Laura Ingraham reported this disturbing discovery, she said, "despite the Fed spending, what, 15.6 billion on cybersecurity, more than the GDP of nearly, what, 75 countries, chinese cyberspies were able to exploit a fundamental gap in Microsoft's cloud, enabling them to hack email accounts at the State Department and other agencies. But this really should come as no surprise, because Microsoft has had a really symbiotic relationship for China for years now."

Ingraham said that Microsoft gave the Chinese government access to the source code for its Windows operating system.

# SOUTH DAKOTA CONSTITUTION

## ARTICLE VII

### ELECTIONS AND RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE

§ 2. Voter qualification. Every United States citizen eighteen years of age or older who has met all residency and registration requirements shall be entitled to vote in all elections and upon all questions submitted to the voters of the state unless disqualified by law for mental incompetence or the conviction of a felony. The Legislature may by law establish reasonable requirements to insure the integrity of the vote.

Each elector who qualified to vote within a precinct shall be entitled to vote in that precinct until he establishes another voting residence. An elector shall never lose his residency for voting solely by reason of his absence from the state.

I harp on the hash verification process because an insider with sufficient knowledge and physical access can do bad things to systems. How do we thwart that? Through good procedures, one of which is checking that what is installed on the system matches exactly with what was certified by the EAC. Under the current guidance from ES&S, an insider now knows specifically which file is not being inspected. It's similar to a bank robber knowing that the camera covering teller #3 is broken.

It sounds like this was also an issue with the stick upgrade process for 6.0.2.0. Was the SoS ever notified?

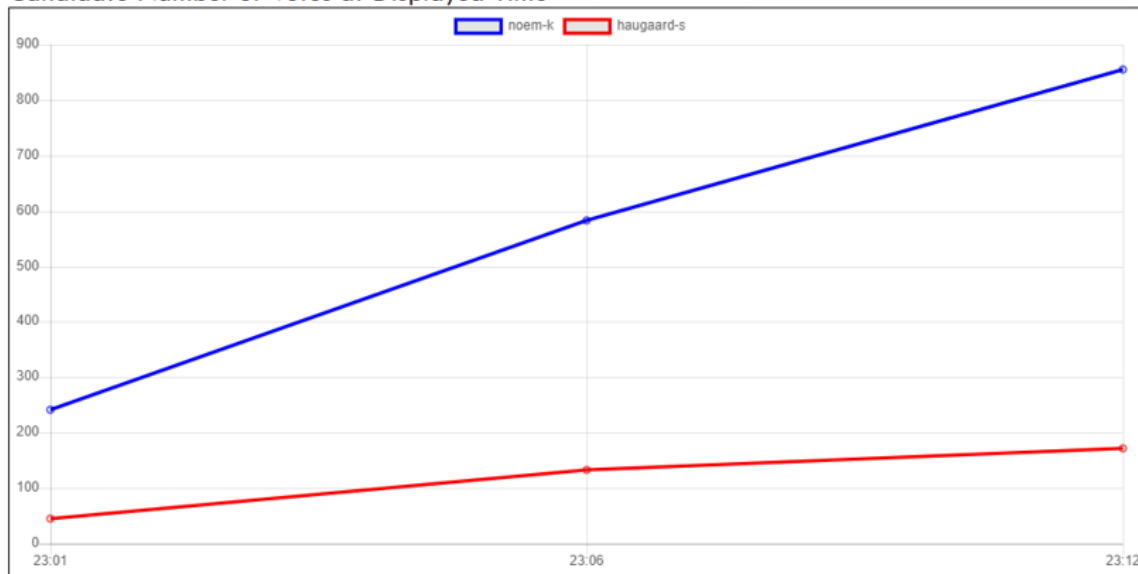

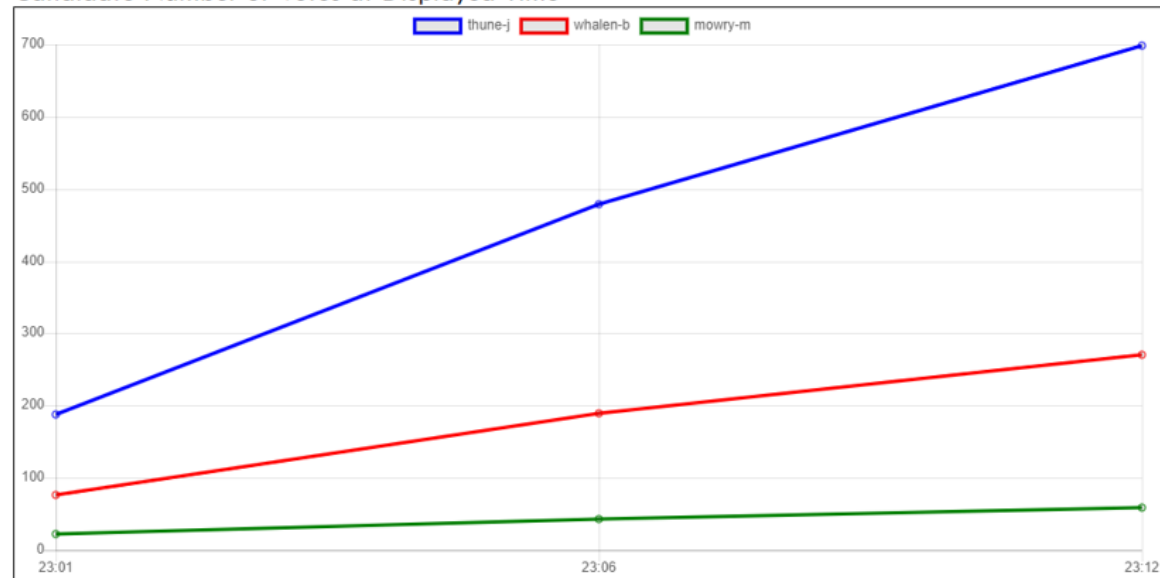

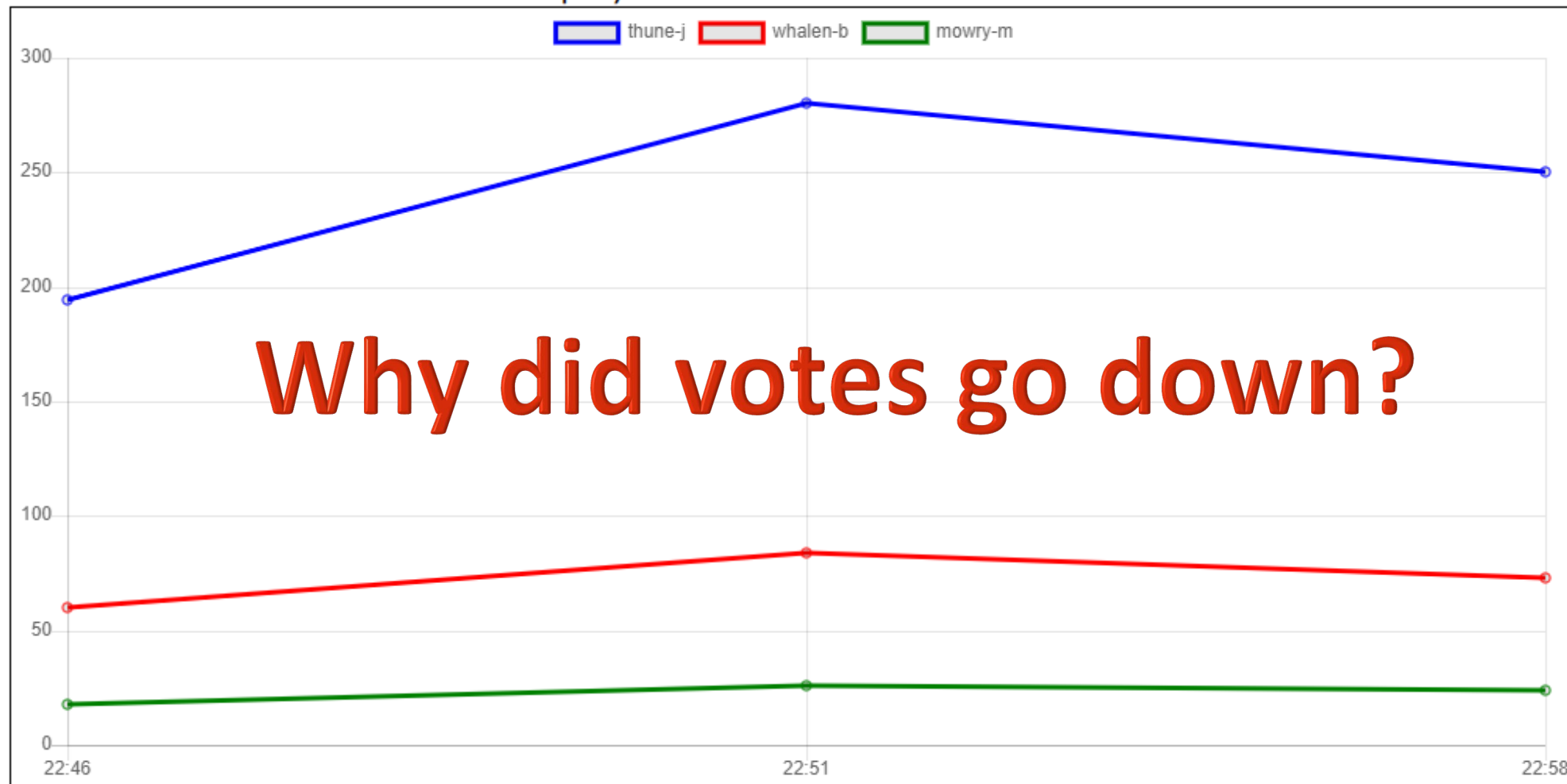

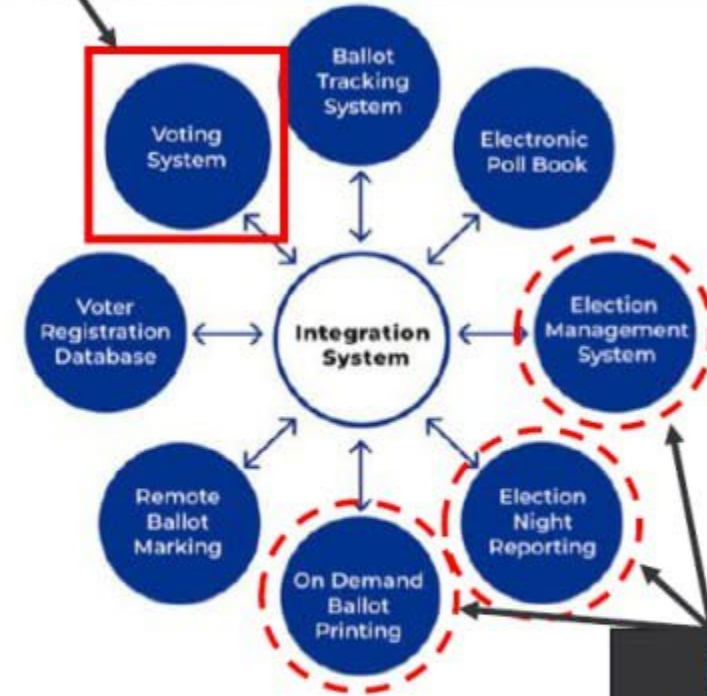

*Before and After: Data flows between election technology components without (left) and with (right) an integration system*

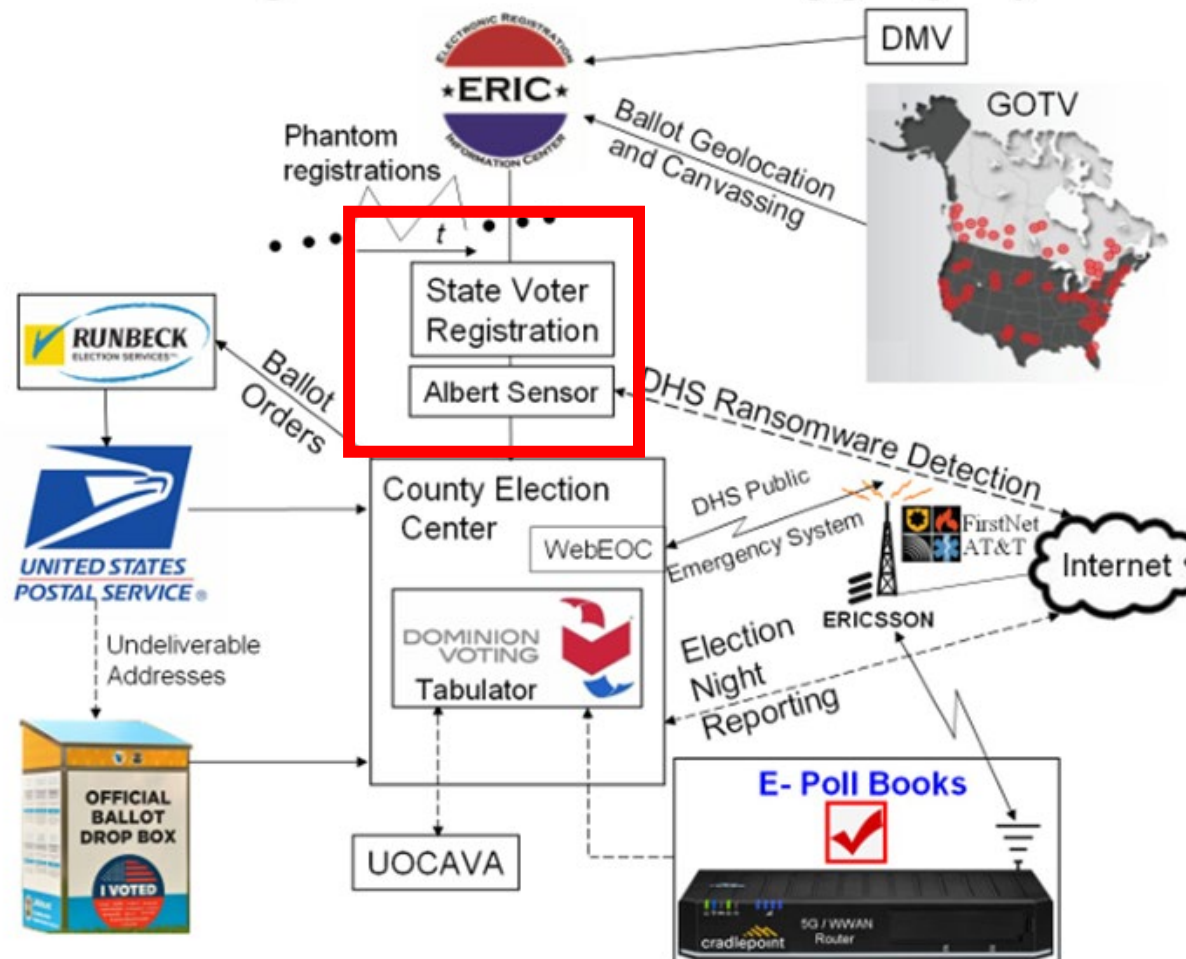

However, South Dakota Secretary of State Steve Barnett and county auditors who run local elections say they have reviewed the concerns and concluded that the electoral process in place in South Dakota is secure and that voters can trust the results of the Nov. 8, 2022, election.

“I’m very confident in our system, which is a bottom-up approach led by auditors at the county level, and I also know that our election laws are strong,” Barnett said. “We have paper ballots, our tabulating machines are not connected to the internet, and a statewide canvass is completed after election day.”

BPro is experienced with the data structure of voter registration data and data conversions through our successful delivery of election systems in six states. This includes building the South Dakota and Washington Voter Registration systems, which changed from “bottom-up” to “top-down” models with the implementation of TotalVote. In addition, BPro has built data exchanges for our customers to participate in both ERIC and Cross Check, in order to compare voter registration data with other states.

“When a person votes on Election Day, the ballot is counted by a tabulator and then transferred into our system,” explains Campea. “Our software reports the results and provides them to the media outlets.”

He adds “We’re the official people who know the results before anyone else.”

BPro staff are the first-receivers of election results in South Dakota and six other states—Montana, North Dakota, Nebraska, Hawaii, New Mexico and most recently Oregon, as well as Sacramento County in California and 11 Minnesota counties.

## Albert Sensor Locations



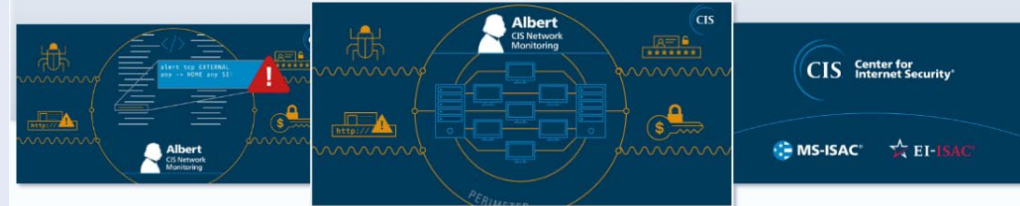
Location of Active Albert Sensors in the U.S. (2019)\*



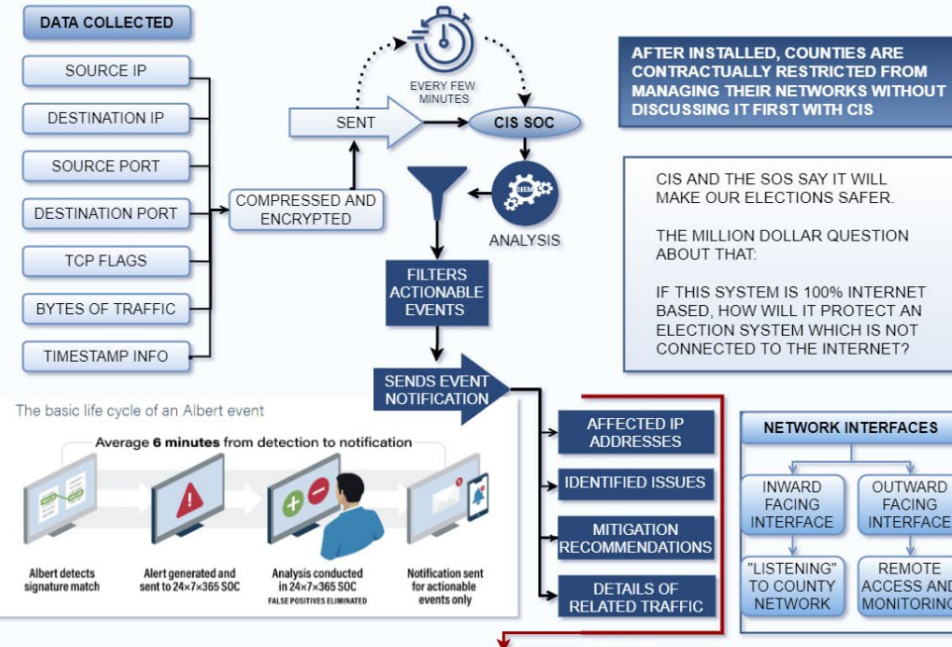

The Committee on the Judiciary and the Select Subcommittee on the Weaponization of the Federal Government have been conducting an investigation into government-induced censorship on social media. Although the investigation is ongoing, information obtained to date has revealed that the **Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA)**—an upstart agency within the Department of Homeland Security (DHS)—has facilitated the censorship of Americans directly and through third-party intermediaries.

Founded in 2018, CISA was originally intended to be an ancillary agency designed to protect “critical infrastructure” and guard against cybersecurity threats.<sup>3</sup> In the years since its creation, however, **CISA metastasized into the nerve center of the federal government’s domestic surveillance and censorship operations on social media.**<sup>4</sup> By 2020, CISA routinely reported social media posts that allegedly spread “disinformation” to social media platforms.<sup>5</sup> By 2021, CISA had a formal “Mis-, Dis-, and Malinformation” (MDM) team.<sup>6</sup> In 2022 and 2023, in response to growing public and private criticism of CISA’s unconstitutional behavior, CISA attempted to camouflage its activities, duplicitously claiming it serves a purely “informational” role.<sup>7</sup>

As defined in 2003 by Homeland Security Presidential Directive 7, the term “critical infrastructure” was formerly used to describe “information technology; telecommunications; chemical; transportation systems, including mass transit, aviation, maritime, ground/surface, and rail and pipeline systems; emergency services; and postal and shipping.”<sup>29</sup> It was not until 2017, shortly after the 2016 election, that President Obama’s DHS Secretary Jeh Johnson designated “election infrastructure” as a “critical infrastructure subsector.”<sup>30</sup>

Ostensibly created to protect the electrical grid and other “critical infrastructure” sectors from cybersecurity threats,<sup>31</sup> CISA, a little-known agency buried in the depths of DHS, soon expanded its mission to combat “foreign disinformation.”<sup>32</sup> Not long thereafter, under the pretext of protecting “election infrastructure,” CISA began surveilling and censoring American citizens online, directly and by proxy.

- CISA is “working with federal partners to mature a whole-of-government approach” to curbing alleged misinformation and disinformation.<sup>8</sup>

- CISA considered the creation of an anti-misinformation “rapid response team” capable of physically deploying across the United States.<sup>9</sup>

- CISA moved its censorship operation to a CISA-funded non-profit after CISA and the Biden Administration were sued in federal court, implicitly admitting that its censorship activities are unconstitutional.<sup>10</sup>

- CISA wanted to use the same CISA-funded non-profit as its mouthpiece to “avoid the appearance of government propaganda.”<sup>11</sup>

- Members of CISA’s advisory committee agonized that it was “only a matter of time before someone realizes we exist and starts asking about our work.”<sup>12</sup>

The Committee and the Select Subcommittee are responsible for investigating “violation[s] of the civil liberties of citizens of the United States.”<sup>13</sup> In accordance with this mandate, this interim staff report on CISA’s violations of the First Amendment and other unconstitutional activities fulfills the obligation to identify and report on the weaponization of the federal government against American citizens. The work, however, is not done. CISA still has not adequately complied with a subpoena for relevant documents, and much more fact-finding is necessary. In order to better inform the Committee’s legislative efforts, the Committee and Select Subcommittee will continue to investigate CISA’s and other Executive Branch agencies’ entanglement with social media platforms.



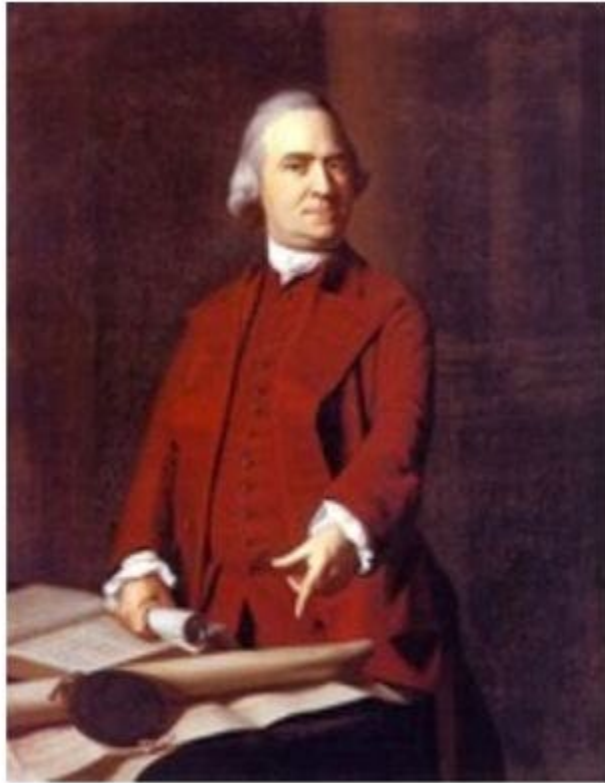

Our state laws require and allow for County Party Central Committee oversight and staffing of the elections. This has been overlooked in the past. We aim to restore full compliance with this local oversight that is a very important part of securing our elections.

**If you are a precinct committee person, you are needed NOW.**
